We Will Not Be Landing in Seattle

On January 15, 2009, Captain Chesley “Sully” Sullenberger taught valuable lessons in leadership. He landed U.S. Airways flight 1549 in the Hudson River, saving the lives of all 150 passengers and crew. After the unexpected bird strike shortly after takeoff that took out both engines, Sully had just four minutes to process the options and lead his crew through a successful water landing.
